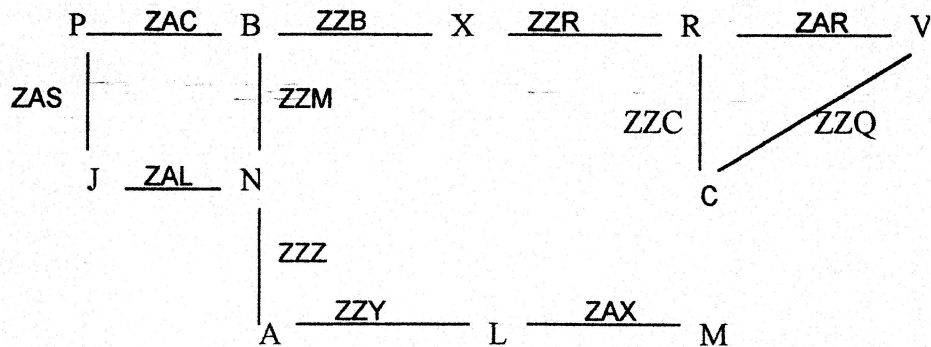


## BOMBE COPIES

The present method of telephoning menus used in Hut 11a is as follows:-



Telephoned as:

"5 across,  
P B X R V  
J N skip C  
Skip A L M  
P to B  
B to X  
X to R

3 down  
drop  
Drop

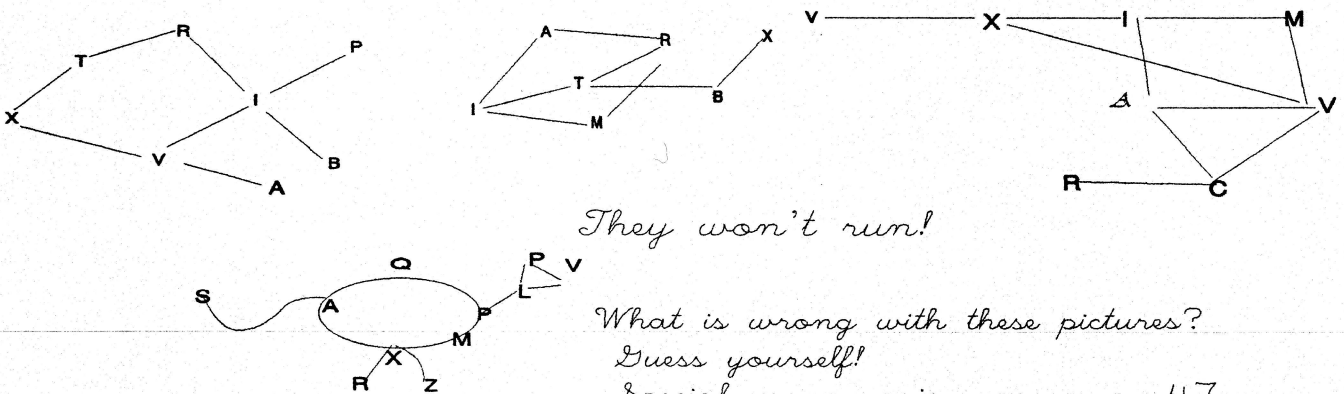
A C  
Z B  
Z R

Etc. "

So in making bombe copies remember:-

- (i) to keep the menu as rectangular as possible (the letters being written in equidistant rows and columns)
- (ii) to keep the menu as far to the LEFT as possible
- (iii) to write the copy on a reasonable-sized piece of paper -  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a sheet of foolscap is the standard size of paper used by the N.R.
